ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

Sokos Hotel Kupittaa Joukahaisenkatu 6 20520 Turku

Your one-night accommodation (Oct 7), in a single room, is covered and booked by the Fulbright Finland Foundation.

Sokos Hotel Kupittaa is located in the Kupittaa area of Turku, a 2-minute walk from the Kupittaa train station and a 20-minute bus ride from the Turku railway station. Check-in starts at 15:00, but luggage can be left at the hotel when you arrive in Turku. Check-in at the hotel can be made after Friday's program has ended. If you are staying additional nights at your own expense, please make sure you pay any out-of-pocket costs. Please note that on the day of your departure, you should remove your luggage from your room by 12:00 noon. You may leave your luggage in the luggage storage at the hotel.

DRESS CODE

The dress code at the seminar is **business casual**. We will be walking as a group between locations, so it is recommended that you also <u>bring comfortable shoes</u>.

ARRIVAL

NOTE! Important information about railway line interruption in Turku

Those of you who travel to Turku by train, please note that there is track work between the Turku central railway station and the Turku Kupittaa station. Our hotel is located right next to the **Turku Kupittaa station**.

If you travel to Turku from/via Helsinki (e.g. those living in Lappeenranta), please search for connections to Turku Kupittaa.

Karoliina Kokko will be at Turku Main Railway Station on Friday at 10:50, so if you arrive then, you can take a taxi with her to the hotel. Let Heidi know at the latest on Tuesday, October 3 if you want to join the taxi ride by sending her an email to <u>Heidi.tiainen@fulbright.fi</u> (cc. Maija and Karoliina). We need to know the exact number of people, so we'll order enough taxis.

When purchasing your travel ticket, please make sure that you have enough time to stop by the hotel to store your luggage before the lunch/program starts on Friday. We recommend you purchase your travel ticket for a train/bus that will arrive in Turku at 11:00 at the latest.

Please note that unfortunately we cannot reimburse taxi or public transportation expenses (with the exception of the taxi with Karoliina from the railway station to Kupittaa).

LUNCH & MEETING YOUR FELLOW GRANTEES

There will be lunch at Restaurant Kårkafe Aurum (Henrikinkatu 2) from 11:00-12.20, which is covered by the organizers. Please join the lunch promptly at <u>11:00 or at 11:30</u> at the very latest. Fulbright Finland Foundation staff will be waiting at Kårkafe Aurum with a Fulbright Finland Foundation sign at 11:00. You will receive a lunch coupon at the venue. Saara will reserve a table for the Finnish graduate students so we can eat together.

Please note that you will not be able to visit your hotel room during the day's program, so please prepare accordingly.

- **12:30-13:35 Preparing for your Fulbright Year, Room Käpy, University of Turku's Main Building** For the Finnish Graduate Grantees only. We will walk to the Main Building together from lunch.
- **13:35-13:45** Introducing the Finnish graduate students to the U.S. Fulbrighters Each of you will shortly introduce yourself to the U.S. grantees before the start of the presentations.
- 14:00-17:25 American Voices Seminar presentations, Tauno Nurmela Hall, University of Turku The audience is mostly university-level students and faculty from the Turku area with an interest in American studies topics. The audience is expecting informative presentations about different aspects of American culture.
- 17:30 Walk (approx. 1,3 km) to Restaurant Boat Svarte Rudolf through some of the Turku sights.

18:00 Dinner at Restaurant Boat Svarte Rudolf

The group will walk together from the university to the restaurant. A buffet menu has been reserved for you. The dinner is hosted by the organizers for the grantees. Please note that water is included, but **other drinks and extras are each person's own responsibility.**
